- RELAX! God put the wiggle in children; do not feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome!
- Sit toward the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what is going on at the altar. They tire of seeing the back of others' heads.
- Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the priests, altar servers, and other ministers.
- Sing the hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical

- behavior by copying you.
- If you have to leave the Mass with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. Jesus said: "Let the children come to me and do not hinder them."

To the members of our Parish:

- The presence of children is a gift to the Church and they are a reminder that our parish is growing.
- Remember that the way we welcome children in our Church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God, and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of worship.
- Please welcome our children and give a smile of encouragement to their parents.

Marriage Preparation Offers Opportunities to Connect/Reconnect

A terrific opportunity for St. Charles to connect with both parishioners and non-parishioners alike is through our Marriage Preparation Program for newly engaged couples. An Archdiocesan requirement for all people seeking to be married in the Church, the Marriage Preparation program offered here at the Parish is a series of low-key classes designed to help young (and sometimes not so young!) couples as they prepare for their future lives together.

Meeting over three Sunday evenings and led by married couples from St. Charles, the Marriage Prep classes give these engaged couples a chance to take a break from all the hectic wedding planning that is probably dominating their days and allow them to spend a few quiet moments reflecting together on their relationship. Topics cov-

ered include Communication, Conflict Resolution, Human Sexuality, and Faith. The classes are not so much instructive in nature as an occasion for the couples to talk with each other about important issues that may crop up in their marriage in the years ahead.

It is also an excellent opportunity for people to connect, or re-connect, with the Parish, and vice-versa! They meet other engaged couples from St. Charles, as well as getting to know the class leaders. It is hoped that these soon-to-be-married couples will come to recognize St. Charles as a caring, supportive and welcoming community. As they get ready to take the first steps on their new life journey, it is a terrific chance for us to let them know that we will always be there for them and that we would love to have them become more deeply involved in Parish life!

St. Charles School and Catholic Social Teaching

St. Charles School provides a program for St. Charles Parish that serves to help families raise their children in a faith-based school environment. The community is focused on the school theme of *Jesus Walks on this Campus*, reminding all members that we are one with one another in finding Christ in each and every member of the school and community, including students, teachers, staff, parents, grandparents, siblings, and more!

With the teachings of Christ at the center, the knowledge and values taught throughout the program integrate character education, Christian service, and Catholic social teachings into instruction, enrichment, and interpersonal relationships. Students and families participate in many constructive learning activities, schoolwide worship and prayer, as well as volunteer service throughout the year to better develop awareness and commitment within every student to the Christian "call to serve."

Catholic social teachings continue to focus each classroom community on the greater needs of people in our world. Social teachings begin in kindergarten and continue through eighth grade, building understanding for the Life and Dignity of the Human Person,

Option for the Poor and Vulnerable, Caring for God's Creation (including one another), and the Call to Family, Community, and Participation. Eighth grade delves into the Catholic social teaching of Solidarity—being one with one another through loyalty and sacrifice for the good of others.

The school's program of Catholic social teaching, as integrated with Christian service, has been so successful that the students themselves began the Community Service Club, which meets regularly on campus to plan their off-site community service activities. As a result, more than 40 students volunteer in monthly service projects to support causes they cooperatively have selected.

Finally, through intentional and regular character education, students learn to manage interpersonal relationships of many types, including building healthy friendships and navigating problematic moments in peer-to-peer struggles. With faith as the center of the school's focus, and structured support from teachers and parents in the community, students and adults alike enjoy the benefits of living and building the reality that Jesus Walks on this Campus!

The Grotto at Borromeo Is Taking (Beautiful) Shape

The Grotto at Borromeo has been a long term project for the Parish and began in earnest in the later part of 2013. The Saint Charles Men's Club and the Parish Building Committee have been the driving forces behind the renovation of the existing Borromeo Patio area to create a peaceful outdoor center for spiritual reflection, education and community growth. Parishioners, Parish Ministries and School Groups will all be able to use the space.

The Grotto at Borromeo is located behind the Parish Center and can be accessed through a walkway to the right of the Center or through the newly remodeled Chapel.

When complete, the Grotto will consist of "Mary's Grotto" (with the rock hillside as its backdrop), a "Spiritual

Walk" along hillside arbors which support the Stations of the Cross (using the stained/slab glass windows which were formerly part of the Church) and a refurbished patio with planned pergola trellis and barbeque area.

Great progress has been made with the Chapel remodeled with glass doors opening onto the Patio, the completion of Mary's Grotto itself and the arbors installed with a number of the Stations hung. The majority of the work has been completed by members of the Men's Club.

The Men's Club kicked off the project with a \$10,000 donation from fundraising and have received pledges from parishioners. However additional participation is still needed in terms of funds but also materials and professional services.
